



## WHAT TO BRING TO THE INITIAL MEETING:

(OR SUPPLY PRIOR TO THE MEETING VIA EMAIL)

### FOR A NEW HOUSE:

- > Your block and section and/or Lot number
- > A site survey/contour plan of the block. If you do not have one, we can get one for you during the design process.
- > Your wants and must haves for your home
- > Any photos, images or ideas for your new home
- > Have an idea of what your budget is
- > Any specific sizes of furniture you want put into your new home
- > Any specific requirements, such as Feng-Shui, Vastu or Accessibility needs

### FOR AN EXTENSION/RENOVATION:

- > Existing house plans, including elevations. If you don't not have these, you can usually obtain them from the local council. If an ACT house, here is the link to the ACT Planning website where you can request your plans. It is suggested to tick all boxes for the files so that every file on record is sent. <https://form.act.gov.au/smartforms/servlet/SmartForm.html?formCode=1073>
- > A site survey, contour plan of your block of completed, if not we can arrange for one during the process.
- > An idea of what you would like to achieve, such as larger areas, additional areas or multi-generational living
- > Photos of the existing house, if you think this would help, but not necessary, as we can do a site visit one engaged as needed.
